Carefully read the terms and conditions below before entering.

1. Registration application form must be submitted by 9.00am Monday 11th September 2023 with payment. NO REFUNDS will be issued for unsuccessful or unfinished films or music videos.

2. \$10 registration to enter per film or music video (no guarantee you will be shortlisted)3. No limit on number of films or music videos per school. (\$10 per single film/music video entry)

4. Films must be uploaded and received by St Andrew's Anglican College by Friday 15th September 2023. Films or music videos received after this date will not be considered in short list showing.

5. All members appearing on the film/music video or listed in the credits must have parent/guardian permission to appear in the film publicly regardless of short-listing outcome.

6. Final upload will have one media release permission with student names to state that the school holds individual permissions for each student participating.

7. Schools are responsible for all media release permissions agreeing that by entering they hold all permissions necessary for public showing of film.

8. By registering to enter and paying for registration you are agreeing to all terms and conditions in this outline.

9. Films/music videos are limited to and will be judged on rubric outlines.

10. Any film/music videos entries will be contacted to confirm or decline short list status.

11. Films/music videos will be judged using the rubric criteria to be considered.

12. All entries and attendees agree to the use of any material recorded or photographed during the St Andrew's S.O.L film festival for marketing and promotion, events, programs, social media, online, printed materials, and services.

13. Films/music videos will be judged and decided on by a select panel. All decisions are final and at the discretion of the judging panel.

14. Schools that enter are invited to participate in the judging of films/music videos entered. No judge is allowed to judge their own school films/music videos, either secondary or primary divisions.

15. Judges decision is final – no correspondence will be entered into-we are volunteers promoting the love of speaking a language other than English, celebrate the winners and lose without excuse.

By Participating in a Film OR music video in the Film Festival, you hereby warrant and represent that your Film/music video conforms to the film/music video requirements set forth below:

1. ALL FILMS AND music videos ARE TO BE G RATED.

2. a) Films/music videos cannot be sexually explicit or suggestive, unnecessarily violent, or derogatory of any ethnic, racial, gender, religious, professional or age group, profane or pornographic, contain nudity or any materially dangerous activity;

3. b) Films/music videos cannot promote alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco, firearms/weapons (or the use of any of the foregoing), any activities that may appear unsafe or dangerous, or any political agenda or message;

4. c) Films/music videos cannot be obscene or offensive, endorse any form of hate or hate group;

5. d) Films/music videos cannot infringe on the right of publicity of any person, living or dead, without permission;

6. e) Films/music videos cannot communicate messages or images inconsistent with the positive images and/or goodwill to which St Andrew's Anglican College wishes to associate; and

7. f) Films/music videos cannot depict, and cannot itself, be in violation of any law; g) Films/music videos must adhere to a standard of dress code in line with their school's 'Free Dress Policy'. By participating in creating a film, you warrant and represent that it (a) does not infringe upon the copyrights, trademarks, rights of privacy, publicity or other intellectual property or other rights of any person or entity; (b) that you have obtained permission from any third party who appears in the Film/music videos or whose name, likeness, voice or other proprietary right is used in the Film/music video, including the Nominee; and (c) that publication of the Film/music videos via various media including Web posting, will not infringe on the rights of any third party. Any such Nominee will indemnify and hold harmless Sponsor and Contest Parties from any claims to the contrary. Any Nominee whose Film includes the likeness of third parties or contains elements not owned by the Nominee (such as, but not limited to, depictions of persons, buildings, trademarks, or logos) must be able to provide legal releases for such use including use by Sponsor of such Film/music video, in a form satisfactory to Sponsor, upon request, prior to award of prize. Any Film/music video that, in the sole opinion of Sponsor, is deemed to be inappropriate for publication is ineligible. All Films/music videos become the sole property of the Sponsor and will not be acknowledged or returned.

Entries that are not in accordance with the guidelines as stated herein or are not received during the Contest Film/music videos Period will be ineligible.
