INFORMATION FOR TEACHERS & CONTESTANTS

Congratulations to all students chosen to represent their school at the 2021 Gold Coast Speech Contest incorporating the Queensland Japanese Speech Contest organised by the Gold Coast Branch of the Modern Language Teachers' Association of Queensland and the Gold Coast campus of Griffith University.

10am – 2pm Your teacher will let you know your competition time and Marshalling Room where you should first report on arrival at the University. Please wear formal school uniform to the contest. Food and entertainment will be available on the day at the University.

2.30pm Winners' names (First, Second and Third, and in some cases Fourth and Fifth) in each category will be posted in the respective Language Marshalling Rooms. Highly Commended certificates will be presented by teachers at schools later. Parents must check results with their child's teacher or at the Marshalling Room. *The MLTAQ is unable to make phone calls with over 1,000 contestants.*

- Students must compete in full school formal uniform
- Contestants should be at their Marshalling Room 15 minutes prior to scheduled judging time given by teacher.
- Teachers will let you know where the Marshalling Room will be prior to the day.
- Students will have their name checked off and given their competition room number.
- Each judging area will have 6 chairs for parents and friends to watch students giving their speech.
- Please note still photography only and no videos are to be taken. Please do not photograph judges.
- Parking is available at the University and all parking charges have been waived for the day.
- Parents must ensure school media consent including Facebook has been given for each contestant.
- Entertainment will be available in the G30 Forecourt from 10am to 2pm and The Junction café will be open there.
